12 MONTHS BEFORE

- Choose date & venue
- Contact venue's on-site wedding coordinator
- Research airfare & room rates for your destination
- Review legal marriage requirements

9 MONTHS BEFORE

- Visit resort
- Tour venue & guest rooms
- Ask about group discounts
- Send out save-the-dates & hotel info

6 MONTHS BEFORE

- Reserve block of rooms
- Book travel
- Book officiant
- Purchase travel & wedding insurance
- Confirm cake, flowers, menu, & decor

3 MONTHS BEFORE

- Send formal invitations
- Create wedding day itinerary for your programs

1 MONTH BEFORE

- Discuss final details with wedding coordinator
- Finalize vows, music, & schedule
- Release any extra rooms from your room blocks
- Have programs printed & obtain additional wedding favors & ship to resort

2 WEEKS BEFORE

- Make sure you have proper documentation to obtain marriage license
- Collect all insurance related documents

1 WEEK BEFORE

- Create a photo shot list for your photographer
- Share contact info with wedding party
- Final check with coordinator
